
Subject: Regarding granting of school recognition as per the rules framed under the Children's Rights to Education Act 2009 and the Karnataka Education Act 1983.


1. According to the rule made under Child Rights Education Act 2009, and the Karnataka Education Act 1983 the recognition has been renewed up to the class for which it was registered. No additional classes or additional sections are allowed to be conducted other than these classes.

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
2. The school shall function under the Karnataka Education Act 1983 and the Child Rights Education Act 2009 and the rules made thereunder.
3. The Child Rights Education Act 2009 and the rules made thereunder shall reserve 25% of the seats for the weaker sections, and the Government shall have the power to enroll the seats reserved for the schools falling under the purview of RTE under RTE. [The government has made rules to facilitate the admission of children in schools near the residence of their parents, and accordingly, if there are government or government-aided educational institutions, children will be admitted to that school.] In case there are no such schools, private schools will be allowed to admit children enrolled by the government and continue their education up to the primary level. These children will be allowed to continue their studies without any discrimination.
4. As explained in Section: 3, the government will release the fees of the children enrolled under the RTE Act as per the rules. Therefore, it is prohibited to collect any fee from these children.
5. The school and the school management are prohibited to collect any kind of capitation fee and voluntary donations from the parents either at the time of admission or later.
6. The school management board shall publish the information on the fees collected by the parents of the children in their school as tuition fees in accordance with the State Government Notification No.: ED:31:PGC:2019, Date:27.07.2019 on the departmental website and on the school notice board. No additional fee shall be collected beyond the prescribed fee.
7. The school/management board shall enroll the students only within the period fixed by the government.
8. The school management board shall not deny admission against the following factors.
 - (i) Due to lack of age proof.
 - (ii) On the basis of caste, religion, place of birth, language.
 - (iii) If admission is sought after the extended period of admission.
9. All safety measures shall be taken as per the RTE Act and Rules, Karnataka Education Act and Rules. [Fire safety and building safety certificate from the concerned authorities and safety of children's learning as per K.S.C.P.CR and NCPCR).
10. The school/management board is as follows:
 - (i) No child shall be kept in any class or expelled from the school till the completion of primary education and secondary education in the school.

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- (ii) No child shall be subjected to physical or mental harassment.
 - (iii) No child shall be required to pass any board examination till the completion of primary education.
 - (iv) Every child who completes primary education shall be given a certificate as prescribed under RTE Rule 21 and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
 - (v) The school shall also admit children with special needs? Special children as per the provisions of the RTE Act and Rules and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
 - (vi) The teachers appointed shall possess the minimum qualifications prescribed for primary and secondary school teachers in the RTE Act and Rules and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules and Government Orders.
 - (vii) The salary and allowances payable to the teachers and the terms and conditions of service shall be as prescribed by the State Government. And the salary of the teachers shall be paid through the Government Notification (Provident Fund (P)) and the bank and other salaries payable. And the employees shall be covered by the Employee State Insurance (ESI).
 - (viii) The teachers shall perform the duties prescribed under Section 24(1) of the Act and Rule 17 of the RTE Act and Rules and Rule 17 of the Karnataka Education Act and Rules and shall not engage themselves in private tuitions for supervisory purposes.
11. To follow the State Curriculum and State Text Books to which the school is affiliated.
 12. The school shall maintain the rules and norms as specified in Section 19 of the Karnataka Education Act. The departmental staff shall be appointed as prescribed in the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
 13. The school buildings and other infrastructure facilities related to the school shall not be given for any commercial activities or political and non-academic activities day or night.
 14. The school shall not be run for the benefit of any person or group or association.
 15. The school should be audited by a Chartered Accountant and a copy should be submitted to the Deputy Director/Block Education Officer by the end of June every year.
 16. The school shall follow the language policy as per the Government Notification (Kannada Language Policy 2016).
 17. The management board and teachers shall act as per the RTE Act and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.



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
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18. The school/management board shall strictly follow the rules and directions of the Government and the Department.
19. It is mandatory to abstract school information in SATS by the end of March of every year as per the rules.
20. In case of violation of the above conditions, the recognition of the school will be cancelled as per the rules framed under the R.T.E. Act 2009 and the Karnataka Education Act 1983.
21. After the completion of the school recognition process, the complete documents and information in the application submitted online by the Governing Board will be made available for public viewing on the departmental website.
22. In case of violation of the above conditions, the recognition of the school will be cancelled as per the rules framed under the R.T.E. Act 2009 and the Karnataka Education Act 1983.
